Digital Technology: New Era

Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse

The training provides an overview of mandated reporting obligations, including how to make a report, protections for those who report, and the liability for failing to report.

Law Enforcements Guide to Pennsylvania Youth Gangs

Identify the "Super Gangs" operating in PA, recognize how gangs represent by calls, clothing, accessories, slang & hidden symbols, recognize and read gang graffiti, use the internet to assess gang activity in your area, understand how gang members think & react do's and don'ts of working with gang members & recognize the warning signs that you are in imminent danger & appropriate responses.
