Representatives from the Montgomery County District Attorney’s Office, the Juvenile Probation Department, the Juvenile Court, the Office of Children and Youth Services, the Youth Center, the Mediation Center and police agencies will present information relating to the operations of the juvenile justice system. The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency will discuss juvenile detention.

The seminar is designed for those who have a vested interest in the juvenile justice field. Police Officers, Juvenile Probation Officers, Social Services, Educators, and Youth Aid Panel Members are encouraged to attend. LIMITED SEATING EXISTS.

The seminar is designed to facilitate discussion in the areas of: the role of the police department during the custody, interview, fingerprinting and detention of juveniles; the Balanced and Restorative Justice Model; the role of the District Attorney’s office and legal considerations such as school searches along with other current case law; the Youth Aid Panel Process; the Petition Process; the role of the Juvenile Probation Department and the specific path the youth follows; recognizing the victims of crimes; the Juvenile Court setting; the role and environment of the Youth Center and the Office of Children and Youth linking with other agencies.
